EducationQuest awards \$1.57 million in need-based scholarship funds to 30 Nebraska colleges *27,000 scholarships worth \$28 million distributed since 1999*

(Lincoln, Neb.) EducationQuest Foundation has awarded \$1.57 million in scholarship funds to 30 nonprofit colleges and universities across Nebraska for the 2022-23 academic year.

The funds are designated for Nebraska undergraduate students who demonstrate financial need. Each college selects students to receive scholarships based on several criteria.

Vice President of Grants and Scholarships Eric Drumheller said, "We are incredibly thankful for our ongoing partnerships with higher education institutions across the state. These funds directly impact students as they address the top barrier to college: a lack of finances. Our mission is to improve access to higher education for Nebraskans, and these funds go a long way toward accomplishing that goal."

Since the scholarship program began in 1999, EducationQuest Foundation has awarded 27,000 scholarships worth more than \$28 million.
