Treve Florum is Director of Outreach Services for EducationQuest Foundation in Lincoln, Nebraska – a position he has held since 2011.

Florum oversees services EducationQuest provides to community agencies statewide. They including helping clients research college options, find scholarship resources, learn about financial aid, complete college applications, and complete the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid). Florum provides these services in Lincoln and southeast Nebraska.

Florum also conducts financial aid and college planning presentations at community agencies and education-related events.

Florum has been with EducationQuest since 2002. He previously served as Outreach Services Manager in Kearney serving central and western Nebraska.

Florum is a member of the Nebraska Association of Student Financial Aid Administrators, Nebraska Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers, Lincoln Knowledge Management Council, and National College Access Network. He is vice president of the board of directors for TeamMates+ (a postsecondary mentoring program), and a member of the Nebraska Children and Families Foundation Education and Employment Committee, and the Lincoln/Lancaster County Human Services Foundation.

Florum graduated from McCook Community College in 1988 with an associate's degree in accounting. He earned a bachelor's degree in education from the University of Nebraska at Kearney in 1992 and a master's degree in sports administration from Georgia Southern University in 2000.

EducationQuest Foundation is a nonprofit organization with a mission to improve access to higher education in Nebraska. Headquartered in Lincoln, EducationQuest provides free college planning services, need-based scholarship programs, college access grants for high schools, college access resources for middle schools, and outreach services for community agencies.
