Creating a Student Aid Account	Let's talk about the FAFSA and creating an account.
FAFSA: HS Graduation Requirement	<p>Nebraska law requires all public high school students to complete and submit the FAFSA, or actively opt out, as a graduation requirement.</p> <p>The law ensures that all Nebraska seniors apply for federal financial aid and encourages you to consider further education beyond high school.</p>
Create an Account	<p>To begin the process of applying for financial aid, create a Federal Student Aid account at <b>studentaid.gov</b>.</p> <p>Your parent will also need an account, and both of you will need a non-school email address.</p> <p>Write down your usernames and passwords because you will need them when you complete the FAFSA each year.</p>
Slide 4	<p>Go to <b>studentaid.gov</b> and click on Create Account.</p> <p>As you continue through the screens, a line at the top will indicate where you are in the process.</p>
Slide 5	<p>Enter your full legal name, and make sure it matches what's on your social security card.</p> <p>Enter your birthdate and Social Security Number.</p>
Slide 6	If your parent does not have a Social Security Number, check the box and hit continue.
Slide 7	This message will pop up on the screen, and the parent will again select " <i>I do NOT have a SSN</i> " and continue through the rest of the questions.
Slide 8	<p>To create an account, you must have a valid email address, but do not use your school email.</p> <p>This account will be active until you leave college or repay your student loans.</p>
Slide 9	The site uses two-factor authentication, so a secure code will be sent to your email. Enter that code on this page.

Slide 10	You may add a mobile phone number and opt in to receive text messages.
Slide 11	Enter your home address and indicate how you prefer to receive communication from Federal Student Aid.
Slide 12	<p>Create your unique username and password using the guidance on the page.</p> <p>Write this down and keep it in a secure place because you will need it every year that you apply for financial aid.</p>
Slide 13	This page provides all the verification methods and a backup code if you cannot use text, email, or an authenticator app.
Slide 14	This page confirms that your account was created.
