# EducationQuest Foundation Do The FAFSA Nebraska Scholarship

#### Rules

# **Sponsor information**

This contest is sponsored and operated by EducationQuest Foundation, 1300 O Street, Lincoln, Nebraska, 68508.

#### **Prize**

A total of sixty (60) one-time (non-renewable) one-thousand-dollar (\$1,000) scholarships will be provided to Nebraska high school seniors who attend any public or independent Nebraska college or university. Twenty (20) awards will be allocated per congressional district based on the student's home address, with eight (8) being awarded in December and twelve (12) being awarded in April. Applicants who are not selected in December will automatically be entered into the April selection cycle.

Recipient colleges must participate in the federal Title IV student aid programs and offer regular in-person on-site coursework in Nebraska.

The student must attend college full-time in the fall immediately following high school graduation. Exceptions can be made on a case-by-case basis if the student graduates early or plans to attend a course of study that does not start until a winter or spring term. Under no circumstances will the fund be held for a 'gap year' or any other delay in enrollment. If the student is unable to use the award, it will be withdrawn and awarded to an alternate recipient.

The awards will be paid directly to the Nebraska college or university on the student's behalf once enrollment, FAFSA completion, and ability to use the funds are confirmed by the college or university in August 2026 for the 2026-27 academic year. The awards may be used for any eligible expenses as defined by the *cost of attendance*. The funds must be applied to the first-term expenses.

The award will be the last to pay, cannot displace or supplant other federal, state, institutional, or private gift aid, and cannot exceed the cost of attendance. If these conditions are not met, the college will notify EducationQuest, and the award offer will be withdrawn and awarded to another applicant. The college will refund any unused funds to EducationQuest.

## Odds of winning

The odds of winning will depend on the number of entries received. However, in no case will the award be made if the sponsor does not receive at least 100 entries per congressional district.

## Participant eligibility requirements

In order to be eligible for the award, the participant must:

- Be a United States citizen or permanent resident,
- Be a Nebraska resident,
- Be currently enrolled in grade 12 at a Nebraska high school with plans to graduate by August 15 of their senior year,

- Plan to attend and be enrolled at an eligible Nebraska college or university in the fall of 2026,
- Have filed a 2026-27 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), which must be fully processed with a valid Student Aid Index (SAI) and have no outstanding verification requests at the time of payment, and
- Have not met their full cost of attendance as defined by the college or university they plan to attend.

EducationQuest Foundation's employees and Board of Directors, as well as their immediate relatives, or any EducationQuest-affiliated company's employees or Boards of Directors, as well as their immediate relatives, are **not** eligible to participate.

#### Contest dates

The contest will open on October 1, 2025, and close on April 15, 2026.

The deadline to be considered in the first drawing is December 5, 2025. Nonrecipients from the first drawing will be automatically entered into the second drawing, which has a deadline of April 15, 2026.

# **Registration Requirements:**

Applicants must complete one online application that captures directory information (name, address, phone number, email), educational information (high school attended, college they plan to attend), and FAFSA filing confirmation information. Multiple applications will not be considered.

### Selection process

Each applicant is assigned a number based on the date the application is submitted. At the close of the award period, EducationQuest will select recipients using a random number generator. Other data points, such as community FAFSA completion rates, may be considered.

The applicant will be notified by one (1) email and one (1) phone call of their selection status within ten (10) days of the stated deadline. They have ten (10) days to respond with their signed scholarship agreement, photo, and month/year of birth (used for identification with the college or university). If the applicant does not respond within ten (10) days, they will forfeit their award. EducationQuest will repeat the process until all funds are awarded.

The recipient's name, photo, hometown, and other information may be released for promotional purposes. However, the recipient may request to be anonymous.

A list of winners can be obtained by contacting EducationQuest following the close of the award.

## Release

Each Participant, or the Participant's legal parent or guardian on such individual's behalf, agrees (except where prohibited by law) to release and discharge, hold harmless and indemnify EducationQuest and all others associated with the development and execution of this Award Program, from any and all tax liability that may be imposed or associated with receipt or use of the awards or prizes, and from and against any and all claims, actions, proceedings, and liability for any damages, expenses, fees, injury, or losses sustained in connection with the Award Program or acceptance, possession, use, misuse or nonuse of an award or prize.

# **Publicity**

Except where prohibited by law, by entering the Award Program, or by winning, Participants, or such individual's parents or legal guardians on their behalf, grant to EducationQuest and its designees the right to publicize the Participant's name, photograph, image, likeness, voice, statements, submission and certain biographical information in all manner and media, worldwide and in perpetuity, for advertising, trade and promotion purposes, worldwide and in perpetuity, in any and all forms of media, now known or hereafter devised (including, without limitation, the Internet), without additional compensation, and without opportunity for review. If, in the opinion of EducationQuest, there is any suspected or actual evidence of tampering with any portion of the Award Program, EducationQuest, in its sole discretion, reserves the right to disqualify any individual who tampers with the Award Program, and/or void any entries submitted fraudulently, to modify or suspend the Award Program, or to terminate the Award Program and conduct a random drawing to award the awards and/or prizes using all eligible, non-suspect entries received as of the termination date. As a condition of entering the Award Program, Participants agree that: (i) under no circumstances will Participants be permitted to obtain awards for, and Participants hereby waive all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, consequential, or any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses; (ii) all causes of action arising out of or connected with this Award Program or the awards/prizes so awarded, shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action; and (iii) any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred and, in no event, shall Participant be entitled to receive attorneys' fees or other legal costs. EducationQuest reserves the right to modify the prize and award procedures. This Award Program and these Official Rules shall be interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Nebraska, without regard to its principles of conflicts of law and jurisdiction, and venue shall be solely within the State of Nebraska.
