EducationQuest Foundation wants Nebraska students and families to know that its staff is continuing to provide free college planning services via phone, virtual appointment, and live chat at [EducationQuest.org](https://www.educationquest.org).

Students who may especially need help right now are high school seniors who haven't completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or whose college plans have been disrupted due to COVID-19, and juniors who are uncertain about how to plan for college.
