



## ***BD Scholarship Program***

BD's Scholarship Program provides financial assistance to the most qualified individuals who are pursuing hard to fill technical careers. The Scholarship award is in the amount of \$6,000 over the course of the program (\$3,000 per year). The awardee will have a 2 year work commitment to BD upon the completion of his/her degree. The scholarship money will be taxable upon graduation.

Scholarships are available for the following technical degrees:

- Electric / Electrical Mechanical
- Mechatronics
- Machine Tool
- Mold Maker
- Manufacturing Engineering Tech

Our requirements are as follows:

- ACT minimum score: 18  
OR
- Compass minimum scores of:
  - Writing: 64
  - Reading: 80
  - Math: 52
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Must be admitted into the program before submitting an application.
